PROGRAM POLICIES

LOANER KITS

In order to be eligible to receive a loaner kit, groups must complete the SBA membership request form and forward the annual fee of \$30.00 to the SBA office.

Priority will be given to SBA applications as follows:

- Schools/groups that wish to become affiliated members of the SBA, form leagues or participate in sanctioned tournaments will be given first priority;
- Areas with natural ice will have priority in December, January and February. Areas with artificial ice will have priority in October, November and March;
- Schools/groups new to the loaner kit program;
- Schools/groups interested in skills clinics.

In all cases we anticipate full usage of this equipment for a number of different grades and classes within a school.

Policies:

- Groups will receive the equipment for a two-week period;
- Each group must forward the equipment to the next user group on time;
- Groups pay for the shipping costs when the equipment is received;
- All forms must be completed properly and sent into the SBA office on time;
- Groups will be charged for loss or damage to equipment.

CLINIC PROGRAM

Instructors are available to come out to your community to teach the skills and rules of broomball. Clinics are available for groups of all ages from kindergarten to adults.

Requirements from the host group for a clinic:

- Complete a request form;
- The host group is required to pay the instructors mileage (\$.25/km payable to the SBA). All other instructor costs are sponsored by the SBA;
- The arena ice surface must be freshly flooded with no snow on the ice;
- Helmets must be worn by all participants (including teachers, instructors, and helpers);
- Organizers/teachers must be in attendance at all times during a clinic.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Groups wishing to host a clinic or participate in our loaner kit program must become an associate member of the SBA. The cost is \$30.00 per year.

THE USE OF HELMETS IS MANDATORY!
